Frequently Referenced

1. No Parking - on streets from 2:00 A.M. to 5:00 A.M. and after two inches of snowfall. Call police if emergency situations arise. No parking on parkways or grass.

2. Open Burning – It is unlawful for any person to cause or allow any open or uncontrolled burning in the City without obtaining a permit.

3. Water Restrictions - apply during the period between May 15 and September 15 inclusive. Even numbered addresses may only water on even numbered calendar days; Odd numbered addresses may only water on odd numbered calendar days. Newly laid sod – you may water for 10 days with prior notification to the Utility Division, call 293-2255.
4. Solicitors - must have a permit-issued by the Police Department- and exhibit it upon request.

Frequently Referenced (cont'd)

5. Sign Posting – Posting of signs for garage sales, political, real estate, etc. are not allowed on parkways or City property.

6. Garage Sales –Limit of three per year. No permit is needed. Signs may be posted <u>only</u> on the property of the sale, not in the parkway. The signs may not exceed four square feet.

7. Deed Certification Stamp – The City requires that deed be certified when a property is transferred through sale or other transfer of real estate. The stamp is acquired at West Chicago City Hall. Application form and further information is available on our website www.westchicago.org.

8. Dogs – Three domestic animals per household. The municipal code prohibits dogs from running at large within the City of West Chicago. Dogs must have a rabbies tag from a veterinarian and be registered in accordance with DuPage County Regulations. No local license required for dogs/cats.
