City of West Chicago Cultural Arts Commission Wednesday, February 19, 2014 Meeting Minutes

- 1. Meeting called to order at 6:09pm. Commission members in attendance: Buddy Plumlee, Mandy Rakow, Anni Holm, Heide Morris, Lew Achenbach, Rosalinda Delgado and Sara Phalen, and City liaison Rosemary Mackey.
- 2. Approval of Meeting Minutes of February 6, 2014: Anni made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Buddy, Motion passed.
- 3. Commission Chairmanship: Buddy has done a great job over the past year, but as it is hard for him to always be at meetings, he is willing to step down from the position if someone else is willing, Anni stated that she would be willing, all were in favor of nominating Anni as the new Chairman of the Commission. Rosemary will relay our nomination to Mayor Pineda.

- 5. Sister City Request for Artwork at City Hall: Sara will reach out to Sister City's and arrange for them to hang their work with the historical materials about the organization.

Fine Arts Fiesta: a new name for the Fine Arts Fiesta spinoff for Blooming Fest was discussed, Artéculture was agreed upon, it will take place in the Gallery basement with set up on Thursday, May 15, opening reception with LMN on the 16th and be up for Blooming hours, Sara will draft up letter for the next meeting. We will all bring ideas to next meeting for logo.

Cultural Arts Scholarship: Rosemary reported that because there is no city money involved the scholarship is not a commission project, the commission has just collaborated with the group of originating artists on this, Buddy and Heide will be the representatives to talk to that group of artists about how to move forward with this and if they would still like the commission to help out and partner in its execution.
