- 3. Future Transition Issues for Gallery 200 as a Division of People Made Visible: website-Rosemary reported on the need to figure out the logistics of transferring the website, Sara and Rosemary will meet with Pete; outstanding keys-all keys will need to be turned into Rosemary or Sara by mid-December, Rosemary will check with the city about changing the locks to have a fresh start with a do not duplicate key set, PMV will also look at proposing a new key system to the City that includes a lock box; door between the basement and the upstairs-can this be shut or locked? Rosemary will check, Rosemary also reported on a question that from last meeting that on branding for Gallery/PMV merger that there is no need to do city representation on materials.
