## WEST CHICAGO LIQUOR/TOBACCO CONTROL COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

## September 6, 2011

1. Call to Order and Establishment of a Quorum:

Mayor Kwasman called the meeting to

order at 6:30 p.m. A quorum was established.

2. Members Present:

Mayor Michael Kwasman

Alderman Becky Stout Alderman Matt Fuesting

3. Staff Present:

Michael Guttman, City Administrator

4. Approval of Minutes:

Alderman Stout moved and Alderman Fuesting seconded a motion to approve the minutes from the May 16, 2011 meeting. Motion unanimously passed by voice vote.

- 5. New Business:
  - a. Ordinance No. 11-O-0048 Request from Wyr Restaurants, LLC d/b/a Mid City Cocktail & Supper Club for a Class A-3 Liquor License

    Owner James Allman talked about his experience in the restaurant business, spending the last 16 years at Reilly's in Lombard. Mayor Kwasman indicated that there will be two conditions to the license: the menu must be in substantially the same form as what was provided as part of the liquor license application and thee will be no live musical entertainment or DJ for at least one year (after the owner can petition the LCC for a change if desired). Alderman Fuesting moved and Alderman Stout seconded a motion to approve Ordinance No. 11-O-0048. Motion passed unanimously.
  - b. Ordinance No. 11-O-0046 Mayor Kwasman reviewed the two issues contained in this Ordinance that was going before the City Council later in the evening: (1) holders of a B-3 Liquor License would be no longer able to have persons under the age of 21 in the establishment; and (2) there would be a \$1,000 surcharge for holders of Class A and Class E licenses to have live entertainment beginning on January 1, 2012.

- 7. **Adjournment:** Alderman Fuesting moved to adjourn. Second, Alderman Stout. Voice vote showed all in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 6:43 p.m.
