MINUTES

ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION

July 17, 2013 7:00 PM

1. Call to Order and Establish Quorum

 - A. Current List

LEED

Item tabled this month. Laura indicated she had informally contacted Gary at the Park district to ask if they considered LEED for the upcoming project. She was told there would be some components of LEED in the new facility, however not all hardware would be. She also shared information from a Park District flyer for the ground breaking event to be held on August 10, 2013.

City landscaping

Lighting Ordinance

Mike continues working on getting an editable copy of Homer Glen's Lighting Ordinance.

Community Garden

Nick mentioned that lead testing was completed at the garden located across from St. Michaels on West Washington. It was found to be lead-free. A discussion on the Thorium issue followed.

Nick would like to try to pursue a community garden through the West Chicago Park District again. He said he had heard they may be interested. St. Charles and Geneva both have established pretty good ones.
