

## PEARL ROAD ACCESS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

## **Construction Newsletter**

October 7, 2014

The purpose of this newsletter is to inform you that the City of West Chicago has awarded the 2014 Pearl Road Access Improvement Project (Project) to Chicagoland Paving Contractors, Inc. Based upon a schedule provided by the contractor, construction is anticipated to begin the week of October 13, 2014, and is anticipated to be completed by November 15, 2014, weather depending.

The Project is a local road improvement at the intersection of Pearl Road and Roosevelt Road (IL Route 38) in West Chicago. The purpose of the Project is to install a concrete island to limit only right-in and right-out vehicle maneuvers at the intersection of Pearl Road at Roosevelt Road. Some of the other key aspects of the Project include new pavement markings, traffic signs, landscaping, and stormwater improvements.

During construction, Pearl Road will be closed north of Roosevelt Road for all traffic. Traffic control signs will be posted along both Pearl Road and Roosevelt Road prior to and during construction notifying residents of the proposed construction and detour routes

Please note that all construction activities are scheduled between 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, and 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM on Saturday.
