December 4, 2014, 7:00 P.M.

1. **Call to Order, Roll Call, and Establishment of a Quorum.** Chairman Beifuss called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Roll call found Aldermen John Banas, James Beifuss, Sandra Dimas, Don Earley, Mark Edwards, Al Hallett and John Smith present.

Also in attendance were Public Works Director Robert Flatter and Executive Secretary Michelle Baldino.

2. **Approval of Minutes.**

A. **Infrastructure Committee Minutes of November 6, 2014.** Alderman Smith made a motion, seconded by Alderman Banas to approve the Meeting Minutes of November 6, 2014 with no changes. Voting Yea: Aldermen Smith, Banas, Beifuss, Dimas, Earley, Edwards, and Hallett. Voting Nay: 0.

3. **Public Participation / Presentations.** None.

4. **Items for Consent.** Chairman Beifuss asked if Committee members if anyone wanted to pull consent items for discussion.

Alderman Earley asked for discussion on Item 4.E., and Chairman Beifuss wanted to discuss Item 4.E., and Item 4. B.

Alderman Dimas made a motion, seconded by Alderman Earley to approve:

- A. **Resolution No. 14-R-0076 – Contract Award – 2015 Parkway Tree Planting**
- C. **Resolution No. 14-R-0078 – Plat of Easement for Fence at 2541 Meadowlark Drive (PIN No. 01-27-209-002)**
- D. **Resolution No. 14-R-0079 – Intergovernmental Agreement with the Winfield Township Road District for Snow Removal Operations**
- F. **Change Order No. 1 & Final – 2014 Metra Station Stair Reconstruction Project – Landmark Contractors, Inc.**

Voting Yea: Aldermen Dimas, Earley, Banas, Beifuss, Edwards, Hallett, and Smith.
Voting Nay: 0.

5. **Items for Discussion.**

- A. **4.B. Resolution No. 14-R-0077 – Contract Award – 2015 Forestry Maintenance Program.** Chairman Beifuss stated that out of seven plan-holders, the City only received three

bids. Of the three bids, two were substantially higher than that of the lowest bidder. He asked staff if there was a reason why. Mr. Flatter stated that the City received similar bids last year. The low bidder, Steve Piper & Sons has held the contract for the past few years, and he has shared with staff that it is better for his company to keep his employees busy during the winter season instead of laying them off, so he does not make much money on this program.

Chairman Beifuss made a motion, seconded by Alderman Smith to approve Resolution No. 14-R-0077 authorizing a Contract with Steve Piper & Sons, Inc., for the 2015 Forestry Maintenance Program. Voting Yea: Aldermen Beifuss, Smith, Banas, Dimas, Earley, Edwalds, and Hallett. Voting Nay: 0.

4.E. Ordinance No. 14-O-0031 – Amending Chapter 15, Section 15-5, and Appendix A, Section 14.12 of the Municipal Code for the Purpose of Excluding Ginkgo and Ash Trees from the City's Approved Tree Planting List. Alderman Earley stated that ornamental pear trees also produce a messy fruit which he feels is worse than that of the Ginkgo tree. He said that there are hundreds of these trees in town and approximately 25% of them still have their leaves. He would like to see Ornamental Pear trees added to the exclusion list. Mr. Flatter said that pear trees are the most popular tree that residents ask for because of their beautiful shape. They do give off an odor, grow quickly, and bear fruit in the fall that lasts throughout the winter. Alderman Earley asked if there are ornamental pear trees that do not bear fruit. Mr. Flatter stated that he would have to research.

Chairman Beifuss said that the Infrastructure Committee is responsible for amending the City Code, Chapter 15 for Parkways, but within the written summary provided, staff is also asking to amend Section 14.12 of the Municipal Code which will affect private property. Chairman Beifuss stated that the Development Committee is responsible for that portion of the request. Mr. Flatter stated that the issue with Ash trees is that when they are planted on private property, they may not be properly treated so the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) will continue to infest parkway trees that the City is already treating.

Alderman Hallett made a motion, seconded by Alderman Earley to direct staff to refer Section 15-5, Appendix A, Section 14.12 to the Development Committee for discussion and then bring back a more comprehensive review of the proposed Ordinance Amendment to exclude certain trees to the Infrastructure Committee at its next meeting in February 2015. Voting Yea: Aldermen Hallett, Earley, Banas, Beifuss, Dimas, Edwalds, and Smith. Voting Nay: 0.

5. A. Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for Wood Street. Mr. Flatter stated that he just found out that DuPage County awarded the City \$261,500.00 for the reconstruction of Wood Street (42-1/2% towards an estimated \$615,000.00 project) and asked for the Infrastructure Committee's recommendation to bring the item to the next City Council meeting for approval so that the project can be engineered and designed for spring construction.

Alderman Banas made a motion, seconded by Alderman Dimas to direct staff to place the CDBG for Wood Street on the agenda for the December 15, 2014 City Council meeting for

approval. Voting Yea: Aldermen Banas, Dimas, Beifuss, Earley, Edwalds, Hallett and Smith. Voting Nay: 0.

6. **Unfinished Business.** None

7. **New Business.**

A. **Cancel the January 1, 2015 Infrastructure Committee meeting.** The Infrastructure Committee unanimously agreed.

8. **Reports from Staff.**

A. Mr. Flatter informed Committee that he just approved the fabrication design for the new railings for the Main Street Pedestrian Tunnel Project. It is anticipated that it will take four to six weeks for fabrication. Chairman Beifuss asked why there is a NO TRESPASSING SIGN posted on the fence. Mr. Flatter stated that it is there only for the fenced in area around the stairs, posted for liability reasons. Chairman Beifuss requested that staff install a sign that states PLEASE USE RAMP with an arrow so pedestrians know that the tunnel is actually open for use.

9. **Adjournment.** At 7:26 P.M., Alderman Dimas made a motion to adjourn seconded by Alderman Banas. Motion was approved by voice vote.

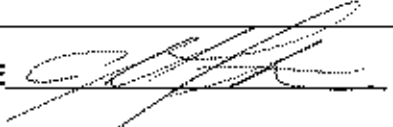

In October 2014, City Council approved the purchase of a 2014 Volvo Model VHD42F200 4x2 Dump Truck with Henderson 10' stainless steel dump body, snow plow hitch, and appurtenances (excluding snow plow, salt spreader, and pre-wet dispensing system) from Fremont Volvo Truck Sales and Service, Inc. of Fremont, Ohio for \$145,799.44. As indicated by staff in its October 20, 2014 City Council Agenda Item Summary, a new snow plow, salt spreader, and anti-icing dispensing system for said truck is to be purchased separately at an estimate cost of \$35,000.00. During the winter 2014/2015 season, the City is utilizing a spare snow plow and salt spreader with the Volvo truck until a new snow plow, salt spreader and anti-icing dispensing system are received.

In December 2014, staff obtained price quotes from three vendors for comparable snow removal equipment installed (i.e., 11' reversible snow plow with Baker Flink Quick Link Hitch, pre-wet dispensing system, and 10' 304 stainless steel dual auger v-box salt spreader with appurtenances). Henderson Truck Equipment-Illinois of Gilberts, Illinois quoted all Henderson equipment installed for an amount not to exceed \$36,262.00; Bonnell Industries, Inc. of Dixon, Illinois quoted all Bonnell equipment for an amount not to exceed \$45,502.00, and Auto Truck Group of Bartlett, Illinois quoted all Flink equipment installed for an amount not to exceed \$56,844.00.

Staff recommends the purchase of one Henderson FSH2 Dual Auger 304 Stainless Steel V-Box Salt Spreader with Dual 75 Gallon Tank Mounted Pre-Wet Dispensing System and One Henderson SnowFoe® 11' Reversible Snow Plow (RSP-11-42-TT-IS-MB) from Henderson Truck Equipment-Illinois of Gilberts, Illinois. Once ordered, it is estimated that it will take at least 3 months to receive the equipment.

The snow removal equipment will be purchased from the Capital Equipment Replacement Fund (04-34-39-4804) in which \$36,000.00 has been budgeted; however, adequate funds are available to cover the additional \$262.00 expenditure.

ACTIONS PROPOSED:

That the West Chicago City Council waive competitive bidding and authorize the purchase of one Henderson FSH2 Dual Auger 304 Stainless Steel V-Box Salt Spreader with Dual 75 Gallon Tank Mounted Pre-Wet Dispensing System and one Henderson SnowFoe® 11' Reversible Snow Plow (RSP-11-42-TT-IS-MB), at a cost not to exceed \$36,262.00, from Henderson Truck Equipment-Illinois of Gilberts, Illinois.

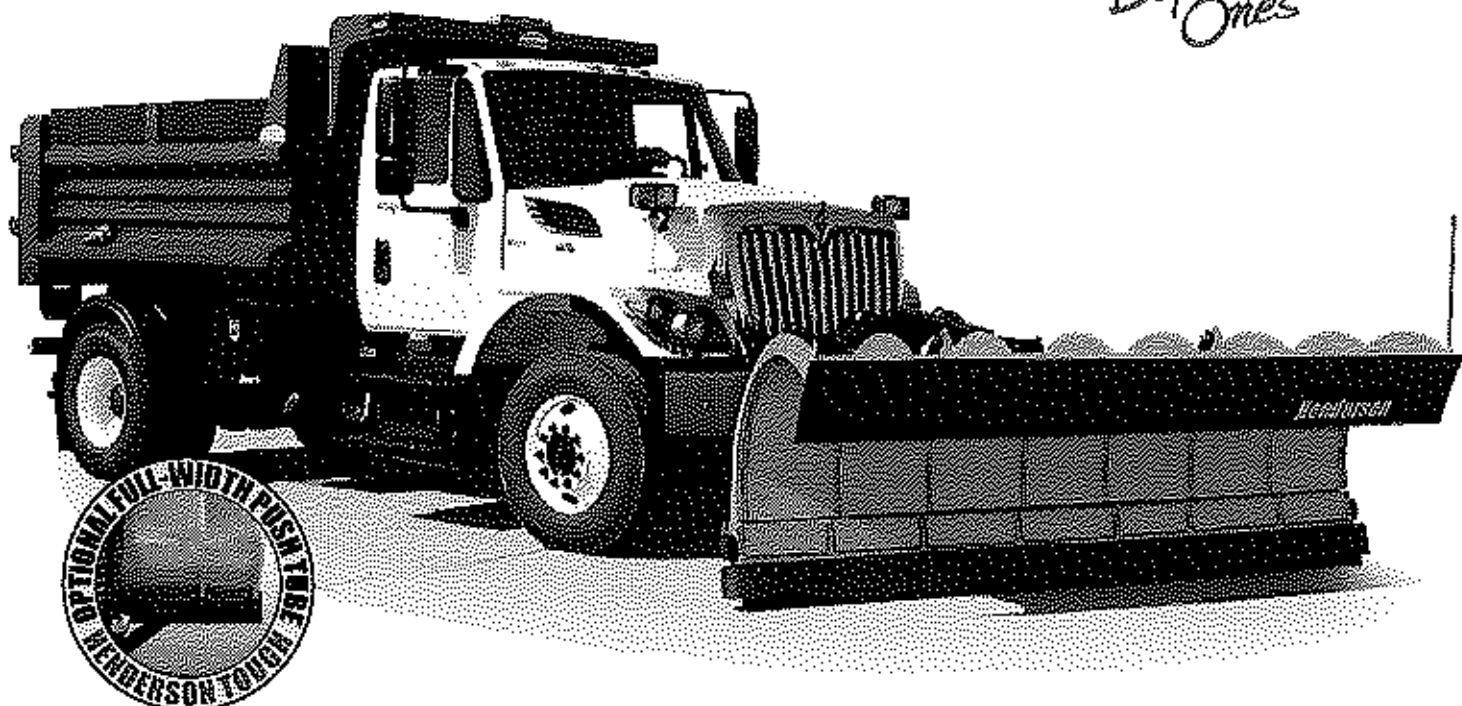

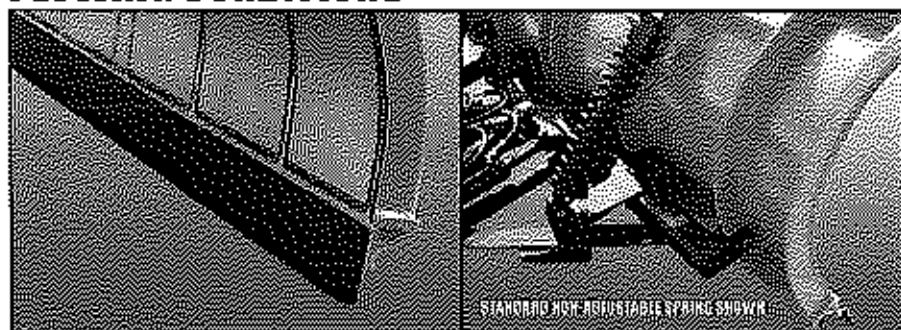

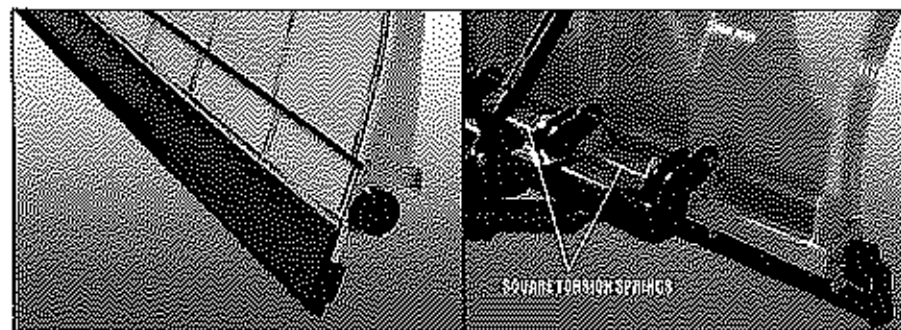

- Top edge of hopper is a formed "J" channel for added rigidity and strength.
- Conveyor is 24" wide, all steel pintle-type chain. The FSH-I and II have 1/4" x 1-1/2" crossbars while the FSH-III has 3/8" x 1-1/2" crossbars. Crossbars are spaced on 4-1/2" centers. Sprockets are cast iron and are keyed to the drive and idler shafts to prevent slippage and maintain chain alignment.

SPECIFICATIONS

BOB

Sides, ends and side supports are of 10 ga. steel and are continuous-seam welded from the inside. Side slope is 45° with front slope at 18° and rear slope at 9°. Floor is replaceable 7 ga. steel. Longwalls are 7 ga. steel continuous-seam welded to the sides on mild steel units. Top edge of hopper is formed "J" channel, 1-5/8" x 3/4". Feedgate is 10 ga. 10" x 18", screwjack adjustable from curb side. Download pressure is reduced by an adjustable inverted vee (optional) to reduce material compaction.

CONVEYOR

Rear discharge pintle chain conveyor is 24" wide. Chain tension adjusting rod is 5/8" stainless steel. Idler adjustment is 4".

SPINNER CHUTE ASSEMBLY

Completely enclosed telescopic design is of 10 ga. steel. Top-mounted hydraulic spinner motor is enclosed in the chute to maximize material flow to the spinner disk, improving spread pattern. It is mounted directly to the spinner for elimination of shaft and bearings. Two (2)

Internal baffles direct material flow onto the spinner disk for directional spread control. Three (3) external adjustable deflectors and one front fixed deflector with overlapping corners contribute to precise control of material spread pattern. The adjustable spinner deflectors are easily replaceable without tools for easy servicing. A quick latching spreader bypass chute diverts material behind the spinner chute for fast unloading. Spinner disk is 20" dia., 10 ga. steel with replaceable hub. Six (6) 10 ga. stainless steel vanes are bolt-on and replaceable.

PAINT

All metal surfaces are high pressure cleaned with a phosphate solution to remove slag, spatter, oxide and oil residue. The entire body is primed with high quality catalyzed primer and then finished with Highway Orange grade enamel. The 201 & 304 stainless steel units are unpainted.

CONTROL VALVE - OPTIONAL

Speed of conveyor and spinner motors is controlled by a dual pressure compensated control valve with a relief pre-set at 1,500 PSI. Valve has twelve (12) detent settings for each circuit and an independent on/off valve to allow start/stop without changing application rate.

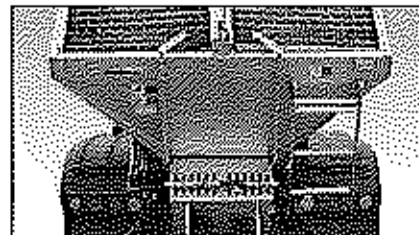

ITEM SUMMARY:

At the December 4, 2014 Infrastructure Committee Meeting, staff proposed an Ordinance that would have amended Chapter 15, Section 15-5 of the City code by removing Ginkgo (genus) and Fraxinus (genus) Ash from Sec. 15-5 (d) "Approved trees" and adding same to the prohibited lists found in Sec. 15-5 (e) "Trees Prohibited" and Appendix A, Section 14.12 "Prohibited vegetation". At said meeting, Committee directed staff to remove reference to amending Appendix A, Section 14.12, from the proposed Ordinance, and present to the Development Committee for consideration; and to add Pyrus (genus) Pear trees, as a prohibited parkway tree in the proposed Ordinance amending Chapter 15, Sections 15-5 (d) and (e).

The previously proposed Ordinance No. 14-O-0031 has been deleted and replaced with the attached proposed Ordinance No. 15-R-0005 for your consideration.

ACTIONS PROPOSED:

Approve Ordinance No. 15-O-0005 amending Chapter 15, Section 15-5 of the City code by removing Ginkgo biloba (species), Pyrus (genus) Pear, and Fraxinus (genus) Ash from the Sec. 15-5 (d) "Approved trees" and adding same to the prohibited lists found in Sec. 15-5 (e) "Trees Prohibited".

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 15 – PUBLIC WAYS, ARTICLE I. – IN GENERAL, SEC. 15-5. – PARKWAY REGULATION, (d) APPROVED TREES, AND (e) TREES PROHIBITED, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF WEST CHICAGO

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of West Chicago, Illinois, in regular session assembled, that the City Code is amended as follows:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 15 – PUBLIC WAYS, Article I. – IN GENERAL, Sec. 15-5. – Parkway regulation. , (d) Approved trees:, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with “Attachment A”.

SECTION 2. That Chapter 15 – PUBLIC WAYS, Article I. – IN GENERAL, Sec. 15-5. – Parkway regulation. , (c) Trees prohibited:, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with “Attachment B”.

SECTION 3. That within Chapter 15 – PUBLIC WAYS, Article I. – IN GENERAL, Sec. 15-5. – Parkway regulation., any reference to “city engineer” is hereby replaced with “Director of Public Works”.

SECTION 4. That within Chapter 15 – PUBLIC WAYS, Article I. – IN GENERAL, Sec. 15-5. – Parkway regulation., any reference to “the engineer department” is hereby replaced with “the Department of Public Works”.

SECTION 5. That the following is hereby added to Chapter 15 – PUBLIC WAYS, Article I. – IN GENERAL, Sec. 15-5. – Parkway regulation.:

“(o) Grandfathered trees: Any existing Ginkgo planted prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, shall be considered grandfathered and all male trees of the species will be allowed to remain. Female species will be allowed to remain, provided that the property owner puts forth effort to collect and remove the fallen fruit in a timely manner each year in order to limit the nuisance it is known to cause. Pyrus (Genus) Pear trees planted prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, shall be considered grandfathered and will be allowed to remain, provided that the property owner puts forth effort to collect and remove the fallen fruit in a timely manner each year in order to limit the nuisance it is known to cause. Fraxinus (genus) Ash planted prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, shall be considered grandfathered and will be allowed to remain provided they are in compliance with Chapter 10 – NUISANCE, Article VI. - INFESTED, DISEASED, DEAD, AND/OR DYING TREES, of the City Code.”

SECTION 6. All Ordinances and Resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflicts, expressly repealed.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication, as provided by law.

SECTION 8. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

On December 15, 2014 City Council approved Ordinance No. 13-O-0030 adopting the Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending December 31, 2015, which included the proposed expenditure of MFT funds in the amount of \$1,062,500. MFT funds are budgeted for the purposes of maintaining Streets, Highways, and Right-of-Ways under the applicable provisions of the Illinois Highway Code.

Each year, the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) requires the City of West Chicago to submit for IDOT approval a Resolution (using IDOT Form BLR 14230) for Maintenance of Streets and Highways by Municipality Under the Illinois Highway Code. The Municipal Estimate of Maintenance Costs form (BLR 14231), the Request for Expenditure/Authorization of Motor Fuel Tax Funds form (BLR 09150), and a letter detailing estimated IMRF and FICA expenditures are also required and must be submitted in conjunction with the resolution. These forms and letters are attached for review and approval.

IMRF and FICA estimated expenditures are not to be included on BLR 14230 and BLR 14231. These expenditures are detailed on BLR 09150 and by separate letter.

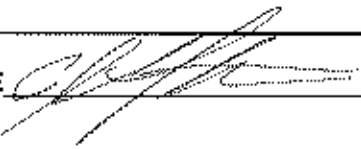

The 2015 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project – Stage 1 resulted from separating the 2014 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project into two separate projects; Stage 1 - completion of nine point repairs, and Stage 2 - completion of approximately 12,400 lineal feet of cured in-place pipe lining. City Council rejected the bids received for 2014 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project in November due to lack of bidders and excessive pricing received. Stage 2 is scheduled to be in March 2015.

The 2015 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project – Stage 1 consists of performing seven point repairs on segments of the City's existing sanitary sewer mains within the area generally bounded by Fremont Street, Illinois Route 59, Grandlake Boulevard and National Street; one point repair in the 200 block of Sherman Street, in the pavement under the former Burlington Railroad tracks, and two point repairs within the rear yards of 1222 and 1234 South Elizabeth Street. The project also consist of two alternate bids to rectify a substantially collapsed sanitary sewer main that is currently located under an existing garage in the rear yard of 920 South Elizabeth Street; Alternate Bid "A") installation of three manholes and approximately 65' of 12" PVC SDR-26 sanitary sewer pipe to reroute the sewer main around the existing garage, and Alternate Bid "B") replacement off the existing sewer main in its currently location with new 12" Certaflo Restrained Joint PVC sanitary sewer pipe using pipe bursting method.

The request for bids was advertised in the Daily Herald on January 5, 2015. All bid documents and plans were made available electronically to interested parties via Quest Construction Data Network. The City received seven bids with Swallow Construction Corporation of Downers Grove, Illinois submitting the lowest base bid of \$160,153.60, with an alternative bid price of \$26,708.50 for Alternative "A", and \$42,193.35 for Alternative "B". The second lowest base bid was submitted by Glenbrook Excavating and Concrete, Inc. of Wauconda, Illinois for \$171,550.00, with an alternative bid price of \$142,200.00 for Alternative "A", and \$71,900.00 for Alternative "B". The third lowest base bid was submitted by Suburban General Construction, Inc. of LaGrange Park, Illinois for \$172,760.00, with an alternative bid price of \$129,215.00 for Alternative "A", and \$59,985.00 for Alternative "B" (see attached bid tabulation sheet for additional clarification).

It is staff's recommendation that a contract be awarded to Swallow Construction Corporation of Downers Grove, Illinois, for the 2015 Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project – Stage 1 with Alternate A, in an amount not to exceed \$186,862.10. It should be noted that Swallow's pricing, with Alternate "A" included, is approximately \$325,000.00 cheaper than the rejected bids received in October of 2014.

Swallow Construction Corporation has previously performed satisfactory work for the City for the Illinois

Route 38 Watermain Relocation Project constructed in 2013. Additional references were checked with positive results.

The above referenced services will be paid for using Sewer Funds (05-34-43-4410), in which \$620,000.00 has been budgeted for various services related to rehabilitation projects for the City's sanitary sewer system.

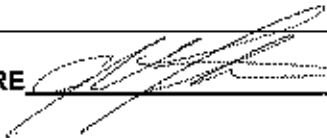

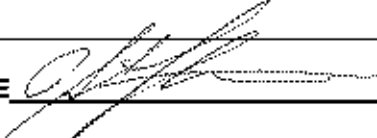

Ball Horticultural at 622 Town Road is located on the City's west side at the southwest corner of the intersection of Town Road and Church Street. In 2009 the City issued permits for the construction of a Premier Laboratory Building Addition, additional parking, stormwater detention basin/BMP facility, and completion of an on-site watermain loop along the north end of the property.

The referenced project has substantially been complete since late 2011; however, the City has not formally accepted the development's public improvements. The Developer has satisfactorily completed all required public improvements, and there has been no maintenance issues observed over the past three years. The developer has posted a Maintenance Letter of Credit (LOC) for the public improvements being accepted per the Subdivision Regulations. The Maintenance LOC will expire on November 5, 2015. The Developer has requested the City accept said public improvements and release their original development security.

The developer has submitted the required Final Waivers of Lien, Deed of Conveyance/Bill of Sale, and as-built drawings, for this project. Staff recommends that City Council approve the following:

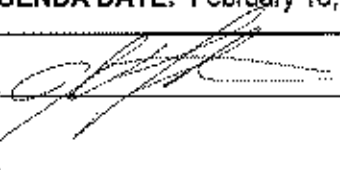

AutoZone at 314 S. Neilnor Boulevard is located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Main Street and Neilnor Boulevard (Illinois Route 59). In 2013 the City issued permits for the construction of the automotive parts retail store, parking, and replacement/relocation of an existing on-site watermain along the west end of the property.

The referenced project has substantially been complete since June 2014; however, the City has not formally accepted the development's public improvements. The Developer has satisfactorily completed all required public improvements, and there have been no maintenance issues over the past several months. The developer has posted a Maintenance Letter of Credit (LOC) for the public improvements being accepted per the Subdivision Regulations. 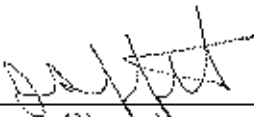

RE: Brush Collection Service Contract For Fiscal Year 2015

The current three-year contract for brush collection service ended on November 30, 2014. Mr. Joseph Kramor has recently indicated to staff that Kramor Tree Specialists, Inc. is interested in continuing to provide brush collection service for another three-year contract period and has requested an opportunity to negotiate pricing with staff. He has not provided a proposal, verbal or written, as of the date of this writing.

Staff is seeking direction from the Infrastructure Committee on how it would like to proceed with the 2015 Brush Collection Program:

1. Should staff meet with Mr. Kramor and negotiate a new contract or prepare plans and specifications for a public bid in February/March 2015?
2. Is the Committee interested in staff obtaining a multi-year contract or a single-year contract?

Program History:

Since 1995, the City annually contracts for its citywide Brush Collection Program. For seven months, from May through November, during the first week of each month, residents are allowed to place brush in their parkway and an independent contractor of the City removes and disposes of it.

Prior to 2009, contracts were awarded as a result of either a public competitive bidding process, or by extending existing contracts if the prior years' pricing was held and satisfactory performance was observed during the previous contract year(s). Over the past twenty years,

Kramer Tree Specialists, Inc. of West Chicago has held the brush collection contract for seventeen of the twenty years.

For 2008, competitive bids were sought and American Ground Cover of West Chicago was determined to be lowest responsible bidder and was awarded the brush collection contract at a total cost of \$58,065.00 (\$8,295/month). American Ground Cover completed all work as specified in the contract documents; however there were numerous calls from residents to the City each month during the program period concerning the level of service provided. Many of the calls related to missed piles or the lengthy time brush sat on parkways before being removed. There were also a number of calls related to debris left in the parkways or street, and damage to parkways caused by the equipment used to remove the piles.

In November 2008, staff received a letter from Mr. Joseph Kramer, President of Kramer Tree Specialists, Inc., requesting consideration to be hired as the City's brush collection contractor for 2009 thru 2011. Per Mr. Kramer's letter, Kramer Tree Specialists, Inc. proposed a three year contract for a fixed annual cost of \$63,000.00 (\$9,000/month for 36 months). On Thursday, February 5, 2009 Staff presented Mr. Kramer's proposal to the Infrastructure Committee and requested direction on how to proceed. Committee directed staff to present a contract to City Council accepting Kramer's three year proposal. On Monday, February 16, 2009, City Council, in regular session assembled, by Resolution No. 09-R-0007, authorized the Mayor to execute a Contract Agreement with Kramer Tree Specialists, Inc. for professional services related to the 2009-2011 Brush Collection Program, for an amount not to exceed \$189,000.00 (\$63,000.00 fixed annual rate). This contract ended on November 30, 2011.

On October 28, 2011 staff received a letter from Joseph Kramer requesting consideration to be hired again as the City's brush collection contractor for 2012 thru 2014. Per Mr. Kramer's letter, Kramer Tree Specialists, Inc. proposed no increase in pricing from the previous annual rate for 2012, an annual cost of \$63,000.00 (\$9,000.00/month for seven months). For 2013 the annual rate would increase to \$66,325.00 (\$9,475.00/month for seven months), and for 2014 the annual rate would increase to \$69,650.00 (\$9,950.00/month for seven months). Committee directed staff to present a contract to City Council accepting Kramer's three-year proposal. On Monday, January 16, 2012, City Council, in regular session assembled, by Resolution No. 12-R-0007, authorized the Mayor to execute a Contract Agreement with Kramer Tree Specialists, Inc. for professional services related to the 2012-2014 Brush Collection Program, for an amount not to exceed \$198,975.00 (Annually 2012 - \$63,000.00 2013 - \$66,325 - 2014 \$69,640.00). This contract ended November 30, 2014.

Kramer Tree Specialists, Inc. has provided excellent service in prior years, typically taking no more than four days to complete the monthly pickup with minimal call backs. If call backs were necessary, response was consistently prompt and courteous.

Mr. Kramer indicated that they have been awarded numerous brush collection contracts, most recently from the City of Batavia and St. Charles Township. Copies of the bid results are attached.

The brush collection program is funded from the Forestry Budget within the General Fund. Annually, the City collects approximately \$75,000 in brush collection revenues.

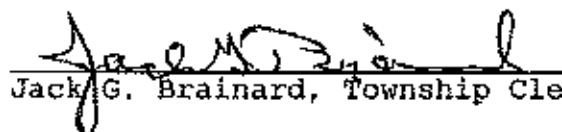

Summary

The Street Division administers the contract for Brush Collection Services, which are provided to approximately 7,500 single-family residences within the City of Batavia.

Background

For the past several years, residents have received a monthly brush collection from May through November. Since 2006 this service has been provided on a year-to-year contract basis by Kramer Tree Specialists, Inc. of West Chicago. When staff became aware that there would be a large increase in the cost of the program beginning in 2014, the issue was brought to the City Council. After discussion during the budget process last November, the City Council directed staff to seek bids. In an effort to keep the cost of the program down, we reduced the size of material to a diameter of 6" or less and also opened the program up to companies that offer similar services using a chipper at the curb. A base bid with the option to renew for the second and third years was sought, as well as an alternate that would extend the contract for up to five years. Emergency labor and equipment rates were also obtained.

Bids were opened on February 25, 2014, with the following results:

**A problem was discovered with the Pessina Tree Service bid, and it was subsequently determined to be an unresponsive bid. The contractor was notified that the bid was rejected.

The low bidder for the Base Bid, which is a three-year program, is Trees "R" Us, while the low bidder for Alternate 1, which is the five-year program, is Kramer Tree Specialists. We've received positive references for Trees "R" Us for emergency storm damage collection done in a few communities; they have completed two years of a three-year curbside brush collection contract in Glen Ellyn. The reference we received from Glen Ellyn was mostly positive. Trees "R" Us falls short of meeting the three-year minimum experience requirement for performing a brush collection program, as specified in the bid documents. Kramer Tree Specialists has provided quality service to the City since 2006.

Recommendations

Staff recommends the five-year program because there is a financial savings over the five-year period, and this option would provide certainty in a market where there have been significant increases. Kramer Tree Specialists has several years' municipal experience.

Motion

Recommend Joint Committee of the Whole and City Council approve Resolution 14-26-R, authorizing execution of a one-year renewable contract for 2014 Brush Collection Services with Kramer Tree Specialists of West Chicago, Illinois, for an amount not to exceed \$176,764.00 for 2014, with the option to extend for a second, third, fourth, and fifth year at prices quoted in contract.

In 2010, *Graf Tree Care* was hired to do an inventory for the City of West Chicago. Upon completion of the report, it was discovered that the city had 2,446 ash trees.

Those 2,446 trees were then evaluated based on their condition, maintenance status, and existing Emerald Ash Borer damage level. *Graf Tree Care* removed 593 trees from the original treatment set, leaving a final treatment set of 1,853 ash trees for the City of West Chicago to put out to bid.

Final 2010 Facts:

The final 2010 inventory included 1,853 ash trees.

Those ash trees had a DBH total of 16,619 inches.

There were 1,142 ash trees that measured greater than seven (7) inches in diameter.

The 1,142 ash trees had a DBH total of 13,454 inches.

These ash trees were intended to be both soil treated and trunk injected.

There were 711 ash trees that measured less than seven (7) inches in diameter.

The 711 ash trees had a DBH total of 3,165 inches.

These ash trees were intended to be soil treated only.

2011

The Emerald Ash Borer Treatment Contract was awarded to *Emerald Tree Care LLC* in July 2011. Wayne White removed an additional 28 trees, but added 10 trees that were not on the original inventory (approved by Tim Wilcox and Mark Harvel). The changes put the final 2011 list at 1,835 ash trees.

To summarize the 28 removals:

- Twelve (12) ash trees had to be removed by the City of West Chicago due to storm damage between the time of inventory and the time of treatment by the awarded bidder.
- Eleven (11) ash trees had to be removed by *Emerald Tree Care LLC* for being too heavily infested with the Emerald Ash Borer.
- Four (4) ash trees had to be removed by *Emerald Tree Care LLC* for being trees that would never flourish (one was dominated by a pear tree; one was topped under some electric lines; etc).
- One (1) ash tree was removed from the data list by *Emerald Tree Care LLC* for being a duplicate entry on the original *Graf Tree Care* inventory.

Final 2011 Facts:

The final 2011 treatment set included 1,835 ash trees.

Those ash trees had a DBH total of 19,056 inches.

There were 1,390 ash trees that measured greater than seven (7) inches in diameter.

The 1,390 ash trees had a DBH total of 16,855 inches.

These ash trees were both soil treated and trunk injected.

There were 445 ash trees that measured less than seven (7) inches in diameter.

The 445 ash trees had a DBH total of 2,201 inches.

These ash trees were soil treated only.

In this first year of the Contract, the ash trees were treated outside of the preferred treatment window (soil treatments in March-April; trunk injections in May-June).

Soil and trunk treatments were completed simultaneously over the course of July 19 – August 12, 2011.

The total cost for 2011 treatments was \$72,699.50.

Emerald Tree Care LLC performed an updated inventory of the Emerald Ash Borer Treatment Contract in the weeks leading up to the soil treatments. It was discovered that four (4) additional trees were lost from the final 2011 treatment set, dropping the list to 1,831 total ash trees for 2012.

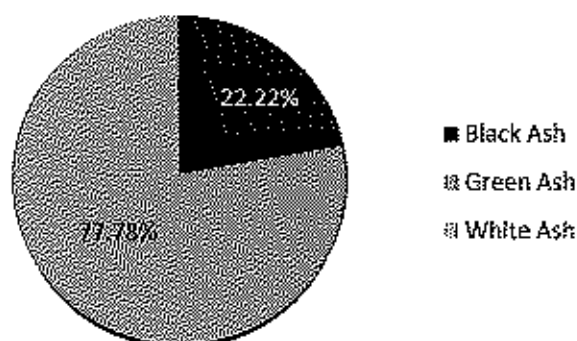
To summarize the four (4) additional removals:

- Three (3) ash trees had to be removed by the City of West Chicago, one of which *Emerald Tree Care LLC* was able confirm as storm damage.
- One (1) ash tree had to be removed by *Emerald Tree Care LLC*, as it had not responded to the 2011 treatment and was too heavily infested with Emerald Ash Borer.

Once the 2012 soil treatments were completed (March 31 – April 9, 2012), *Emerald Tree Care LLC* wanted to perform an evaluation of the treatment set. May 2012 was the first time the ash trees would leaf-out after the full 2011 treatment and the 2012 soil treatment. Wayne categorized the 1,831 ash trees into three categories: good (green), watch (yellow), and remove (red).

The evaluation results removed 45 ash trees from the contract. This finalized the 2012 treatment set to consist of 1,786 ash trees. See below for a species breakdown and individual listing of the 45 removals.

2012 Removed Ash Trees



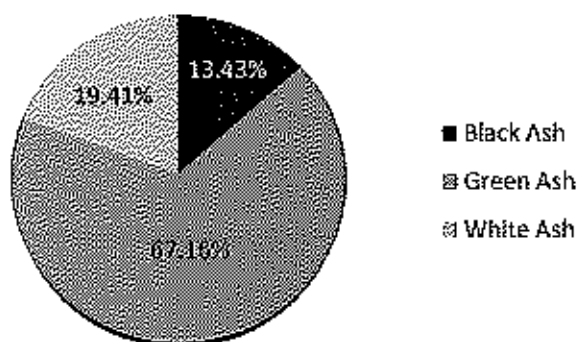

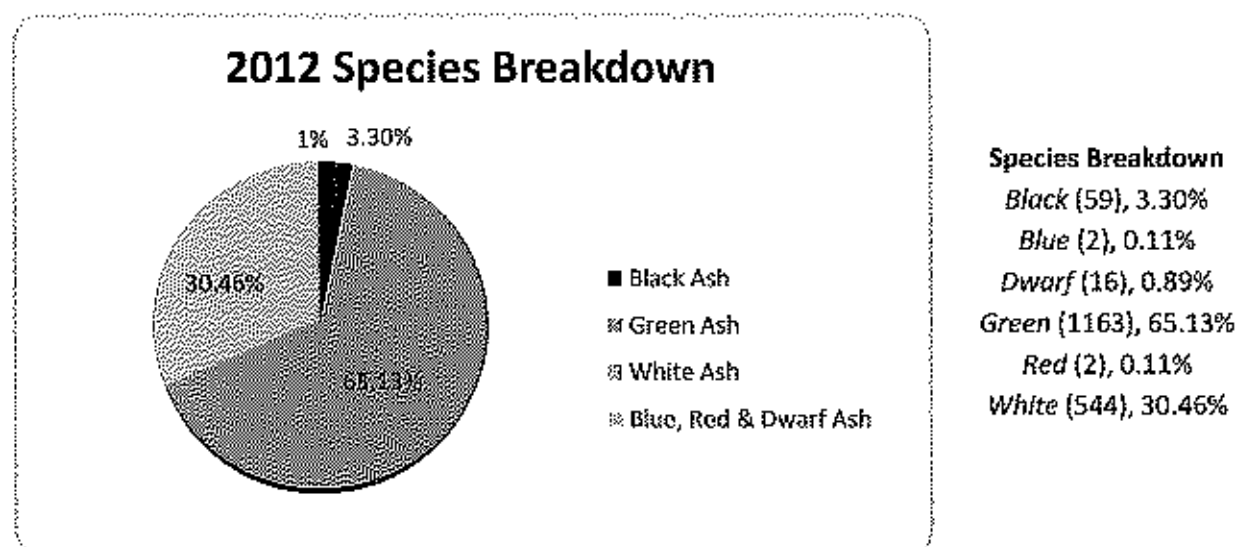

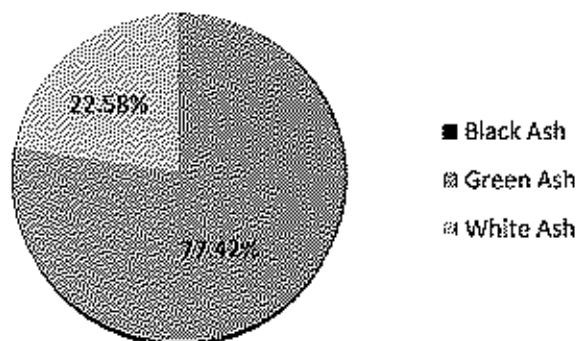

2012-13 Removed Ash Trees

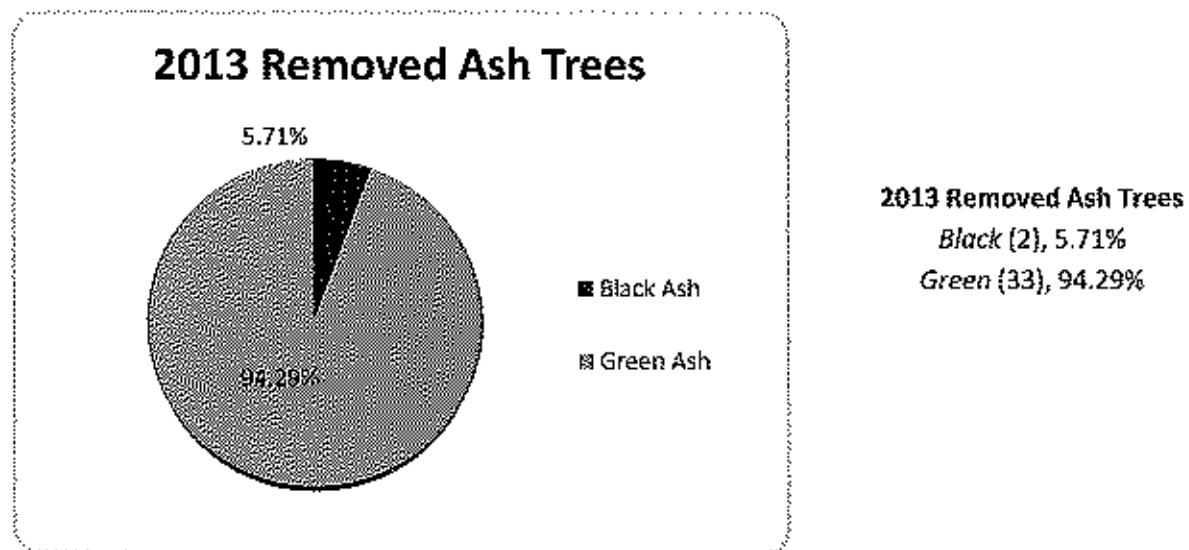

Once the 2013 soil treatments were completed (April 15 – 25, 2013), *Emerald Tree Care LLC* performed an evaluation of the treatment set. Wayne expected this to be a very revealing evaluation, as successes and failures would begin to show. The ash trees had received full treatments in 2011 (late) and 2012 (timely), and also the 2013 soil treatment. As before, the treatment set categorized the 1,724 ash trees into three categories: good (green), watch (yellow), and remove (red).

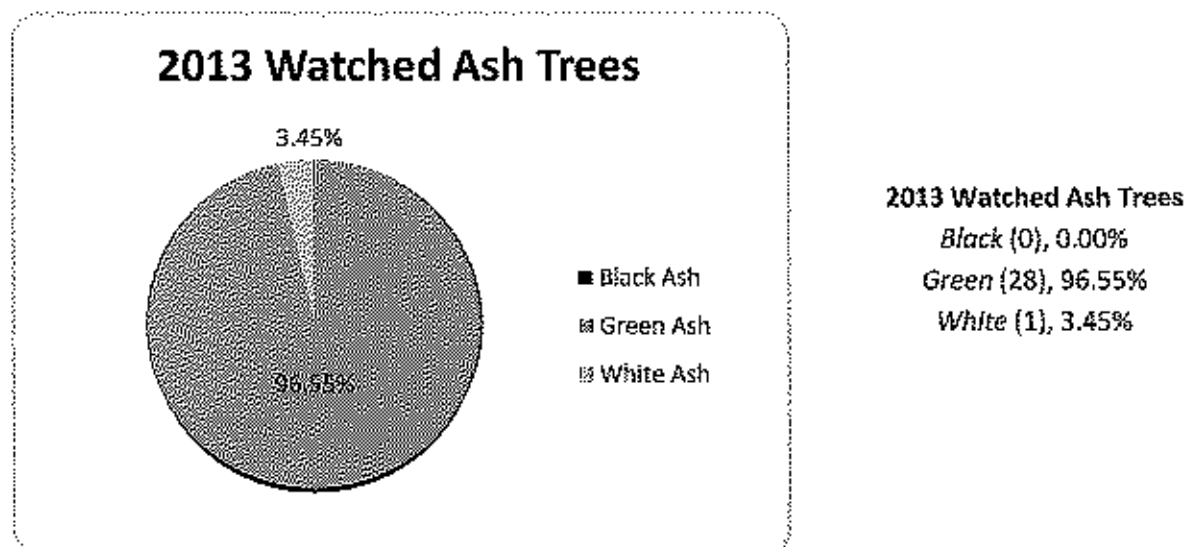

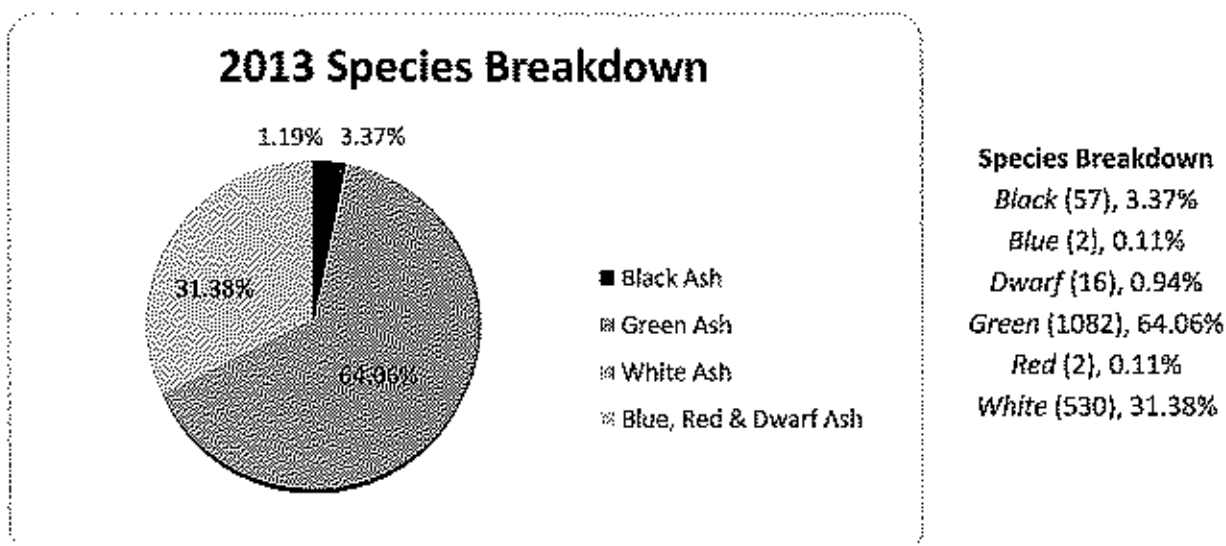

Upon completion of the 2013 treatments, the 1,689 ash trees in the Emerald Ash Borer Treatment Contract fell into this species breakdown.



Final 2013 Facts:

The final 2013 treatment set included 1,689 ash trees.

Those ash trees had a DBH total of 17,870 inches.

There were 1,349 ash trees that measured greater than seven (7) inches in diameter.

The 1,349 ash trees had a DBH total of 16,139 inches.

These ash trees were both soil treated and trunk injected.

Included in the soil treatments were the 35 trees that were removed prior to trunk injections.

Total soil treated inches were 18,388.

The removed trees totaled 503 inches and are not part of the final inch count.

There were 338 ash trees that measured less than seven (7) inches in diameter.

The 338 ash trees had a DBH total of 1,731 inches.

These ash trees were only soil treated.

Soil treatments were completed over the course of April 15 – 25, 2013.

Trunk injections were completed over the course of May 25 – June 3, 2013.

The total cost for 2013 treatments was \$69,788.10.

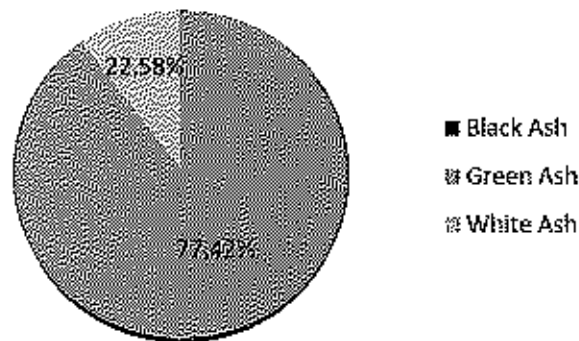

To summarize the 39 removals:

- Thirty-one (31) ash trees had to be removed by the City of West Chicago due to multiple reasons. (Storm damage, Emerald Ash Borer damage, etc. caught between the end of trunk injections in 2013 and the start of soil treatments in 2014.)
- Eight (8) ash trees had to be removed by *Emerald Tree Care LLC*, as it was clear they had not responded to prior treatment.

For the first time since the 2011 treatment, there was another ash tree discovered that was not part of the *Graf Tree Care* 2010 inventory. Wayne made the call to do the soil treatment, and it will be included in the evaluation prior to trunk injections. This brings the total ash trees in West Chicago to 1,651.

Now that the 2014 soil treatments have been completed (April 10 – 20, 2014), *Emerald Tree Care LLC* has noted that it will soon be time to perform an evaluation of the treatment set. As before, the treatment set will categorize the 1,651 ash trees into three categories: good (green), watch (yellow), and remove (red).

Current 2014 Facts:

The current 2014 treatment set includes 1,651 ash trees.

Those ash trees have a DBH total of 18,167 inches.

At the moment, there are 1,412 ash trees that measure greater than seven (7) inches in diameter.

The 1,412 ash trees have a DBH total of 16,901 inches.

These ash trees were soil treated with the intention of being trunk injected.

There are 239 ash trees that measure less than seven (7) inches in diameter.

The 239 ash trees have a DBH total of 1,266 inches.

These ash trees are being soil treated only.

Soil treatments were completed over the course of April 10 – 20, 2014.

Trunk injections will be scheduled for when the trees are fully leafed out – we expect June.

In the pages that follow is a master list of the 1,651 ash tree treatment list in order by street name. The included information for each tree is: tag, address, species, ward, *Emerald Tree Care LLC* condition, and 2014 DBH measurement. A "G" in the *Emerald Tree Care LLC* condition column indicates a good tree, while a "Y" indicates a tree on the watch list.
