- 1. Call to Order, Roll Call and Establishment of a Quorum: Meeting called to order at 7:22pm, in attendance: Ryan Virnich, Buddy Plumlee, Uwe Gsedl, Sara Phalen and Anni Holm. City staff liaison Rosemary Mackey also in attendance.
- 2. Approval of Meeting Minutes of July 7, 2016 & July 22, 2016: Ryan made a motion to approve minutes from July 7 and July 22, Uwe seconded, all in favor.
- 3. Welcome New Commission Member Gail Cannata: Gail is the creative director of the Gallery Theater, she lives in West Chicago but couldn't be present this evening; she wants to build upon the performing arts in town.
- 4. Update Mosaic Mural Project: Buddy passed around 4 ideas he has for the mural-focusing on industrial theme, transportation, time, communication; Public Works has offered up three plaques that they have that can be used if we desire that talk about the train wheel; weather and simplicity of design will be a factor in order to do a side in one day; Buddy will make a design and layout the tile so that it can be put together quickly; cover with a tarp until complete so that we can do an unveiling; make a request to have the wheel mounted as soon as possible; start working on September 17<sup>th</sup> and the following Saturdays (use museum tent if rains); preference for a wheels, clock, gears, switches, and arrows design
  - a. Talked about leaving the wheel the same as it is now-weathered; do not sand blast and paint
  - b. Need to include maintenance for all public art
  - c. Dedication of the mosaic on October 22<sup>nd</sup> 3pm; invitation that looks like a train schedule
- 5. Update of Public Art Master Plan Efforts: two jot forms are on the city website, we have received a few submissions, school district will provide us a list of what they have in the schools even if they are not available for the public to see; park district and library have also been asked to provide a list; question of whether we should allow artists outside the city to submit? Yes, but how? Rosemary will work on a new form and a new press release; should we add an initial deadline
