- 1. Call to Order, Roll Call and Establishment of a Quorum 7:06pm: Gail, Buddy, Rosemary, Lew, Adrianna, Sara, Anni
- 2. Approval of Meeting Minutes from December 7, 2017: Gail made a motion, Anni seconded, all in favor
- 3. Update on Bike Rack Art: Rosemary got some information from Rob-11 bike racks, 6 single loop (art work limited to 19" width, max height of 20", 5 multiple loop (art work limited to 8" width, max height of 20"; dimensions for the art work is different depending on the two types, but can be any shape and material, manufacturer did drill two holes on each bar for mounting -artists need to factor in the two holes when they are designing (each bar has 2 3/8" diameter holes predrilled which are spaced 6" apart); we have to go to bid on the manufacturing
  - a. Buddy talked to Jim O'Keefe at Elite Manufacturing-metal fabricator they have an inhouse designer Matt Nelson who might be able to fabricate the pieces, they could laser cut pieces and powder coat them, turnaround is pretty quick; we would need to ask about etching
  - b. Call for art would list that it was for only positive and negative space
  - c. Andy Koslawski Koslowski would still like to be considered as a fabricator -could make a bid on manufacturing
  - d. Give kids template with holes marked in specific size, let them know it won't be an exact replicate, replicate that it will need to be made fabricatorable-fabricated from their design.
  - e. Ask manufacturer for possibilities for
  - f. Lew is going to draft up template on scalable dimensions and explanation packet for teacher
    - i. Rectangular 8" x 20"; circle 19" x 19" (template is a 4" x 10" rectangle and a circle) -with no holes or bar
  - g. We won't know how many to pick until we see them
  - h. Rosemary will talk to Dr. Johns about us presenting this to Board and then try to get on January 18th agenda
    - i. We develop a script to present that includes -Sara will draft up a packet presentation (one piece of the public art master plan, and make it clear that we would choose amongst the kids work -pick up to 11
    - ii. Revamp to do actual integration of the project into the school, involving the kids,
    - iii. Goal is mid-April
  - i. Display at Blooming Fest-maybe laminate and show outside
