- **5. Sign Posting** Posting of signs for garage sales, political, real estate, etc. are not allowed on parkways or City property.
- **6. Garage Sales** –Limit of three per year. No permit is needed. Signs may be posted only on the property of the sale, not in the parkway. The signs may not exceed four square feet.
- **7. Deed Certification Stamp** The City requires that deed be certified when a property is transferred through sale or other transfer of real estate. The stamp is acquired at West Chicago City Hall. Application form and further information is available on our website www.westchicago.org.
- **8. Dogs** Three domestic animals per household. The municipal code prohibits dogs from running at large within the City of West Chicago. Dogs must have a rabbies tag from a veterinarian and be registered in accordance with DuPage County Regulations. No local license required for dogs/cats.
