# PROCLAMATION SUPPORTING THE UNITED STATES SURGEON GENERAL'S CALL TO ACTION TO PROMOTE WALKING AND WALKABLE COMMUNITIES

WHEREAS, One out of every two U.S. adults is living with a chronic disease, such as heart disease, cancer, or diabetes; and

WHEREAS, These diseases are the leading causes of premature death and disability and leading drivers of the nation's \$3.5 trillion in annual healthcare costs; and

WHEREAS, The health of a community's workforce affects economic development and chronic disease increases costs to employers in lost productivity and higher health care expenditures; and

WHEREAS, Physical activity can reduce illness from chronic diseases and premature death. Regular physical activity helps prevent risk factors for disease (such as high blood pressure and weight gain) and protects against multiple chronic diseases (such as heart disease, stroke, some cancers, type 2 diabetes, and depression); and

**WHEREAS**, An individual's decision to walk can be made easier by programs and policies that provide opportunities and encouragement for walking and by improvements to community walkability; and

WHEREAS, Step It Up! The Surgeon General's Call to Action to Promote Walking and Walkable Communities calls on Americans to be more physically active through walking and calls on communities to better support walking and walkability; and

WHEREAS, Step It Up! provides evidence-based strategies to support walking and walkable communities; and

WHEREAS, local government can play an important role in promoting physical activity and building walkable communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of West Chicago supports the efforts of Healthy West Chicago and the National Forum for Heart Disease and Stroke Prevention through the Virtual Move with the Mayor Campaign; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the City of West Chicago supports the United States Surgeon General's *Call to Action to Promote Walking and Walkable Communities*; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the City of West Chicago will encourage all cities to develop initiatives and programs that support the goals and strategies related to walking and walkable communities.

#### **National Rail Safety Week**

WHEREAS, 2,220 rail grad crossing collisions resulted in 812 personal injuries and were responsible for 294 fatalities in the United States during 2019; and

WHEREAS, 1,111 trespassing incidents have occurred in the United States resulting in 579 pedestrians being killed and another 532 injured while trespassing on railroad property rights of way during 2019; and

WHEREAS, educating and informing the public about rail safety, reminding the public that railroad right of ways are private property, enhancing public awareness of the dangers associated with highway rail grade crossings, ensuring pedestrians and motorists are looking and listening while near railways, and obeying established traffic laws will reduce the number of fatalities and injuries; and

WHEREAS, the International Association of Chiefs of Police, National Operation Lifesaver, United States Department of Transportation, and all local, state, county, and railroad law enforcement officers, first responders, and railroad corporations commit to partnering together in an effort to educate at a national level all aspects of railroad safety, to enforce applicable laws in support of National Rail Safety Week.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that I, Ruben Pineda, Mayor of West Chicago, do hereby attest my full support proclaiming September 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup>, 2020, National Rail Safety Week and I encourage all citizens to recognize the importance of rail safety education.

#### CITY OF WEST CHICAGO - 475 Main Street CITY COUNCIL MINUTES Regular Meeting August 17, 2020

The City Council meeting of August 17, 2020, was held partly remote (via Zoom) and partly in person due to the coronavirus pandemic.

- 1. Call to Order. Mayor Ruben Pineda (in person) called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The Mayor said it was determined that in person meetings are not practical or pertinent.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance. Alderman Brown led all in the pledge of allegiance.
- Invocation. There was no invocation.
- 4. Roll Call and Establishment of a Quorum.

Roll call found Aldermen James E. Beifuss, Jr., Heather Brown, Jayme Sheahan, Alton Hallett, Michael D. Ferguson, Sandy Dimas, Melissa Birch-Ferguson, Christopher Swiatek, Jeanne Short, John E. Jakabcsin, and Noreen Ligino-Kubinski present remotely. Alderman Matthew Garling was in person.

Aldermen Lori J. Chassee and Rebecca Stout were absent. The Mayor announced a quorum.

Also in attendance in person were City Administrator Michael Guttman, Chief of Police Mike Uplegger and Deputy Chief of Police Chris Shackelford.

City Clerk Nancy M. Smith and City Attorney Bond attended remotely.

- 5. Public Participation. There was no public participation.
- 6. City Council Meeting Minutes of August 3, 2020. Alderman Jakabcsin made a motion, seconded by Alderman Ferguson, to approve the minutes of August 3, 2020, with corrections made before the minutes were posted on the City's website.

 Reports by Committee: From Item 8.B. <u>Ordinance 20-O-0015</u> - An Ordinance Granting a Zoning Variance for Signage - 250 South Neltnor Boulevard

Alderman Birch-Ferguson made a motion, seconded by Alderman Hallett, to adopt Ordinance 20-O-0015. During discussion, Alderman Garling pointed out that the sign would be directly below a power line, which he would rather not see a variance for at this time. Alderman Beifuss had questions about the height of the proposed sign. Alderman Brown would have liked to see this issue go to committee to make sure everything is up to standards that the City Council

would like to see. Alderman Beifuss also would have liked to see this matter go to committee. Alderman Dimas said staff looked at various avenues to make it conforming and none were available except to be in the same place, so she thought it should go forward. Alderman Jakabcsin agreed. Alderman Beifuss was concerned that it is right near the sidewalk where people walk and bike. He asked if the City Administrator could give reasons for the height of the sign. City Administrator Guttman said he and Community Development Director Tom Dabareiner worked on this and gave the dimensions. The Mayor said staff worked on this matter and this is the best option. Alderman Short asked if it could fall again. That would be unlikely. The Mayor said if the Council rejects the variance, the owner can keep the old sign in perpetuity. Alderman Beifuss said the new sign is an improvement and he feels satisfied. Alderman Ferguson said the new sign will not be detrimental because it is being restored to its original state.

#### ITEM SUMMARY:

Public Works recently sought pricing for sealcoating and striping services of:

- City Hall Parking Lot
- Police Station Parking Lot
- Water Treatment Plant Parking Lot
- Salt Storage Facility Parking Lot (1350 W. Hawthorne Lane)
- Glen Oak Cemetery
- Driveways at all Well and Lift Stations

Proposals were sought from five contractors who had previously performed sealcoating and striping services for the City, or who previously requested to be placed on the City vendor list. Only two contractors responded to the City's RFP and I have attached a tabulation of pricing received. Hushion Pavement Maintenance, Inc.'s proposals, which totaled \$42,059.00, were substantially lower than Midwest Sealcoat's proposals of \$112,836.00.

It is staff's opinion that the proposals received, and/or reason other contractors did not submit a proposal, were reflective of the performance requirements identified in the City's Request For Proposal (RFP) documents, which included:

- 1. Contractor must be able to complete work prior to November 1, 2020.
- 2. Contractor must be willing to perform services in phases, after normal business hours, and/or on weekends, if determined necessary by City.
- 3. Contractor must comply with City's insurance requirements.
- 4. Payment of prevailing wages will be required with submittal of waivers of lien and certified payroll where appropriate and applicable.

The last time these parking lots received a protective layer of sealcoat was 2016. Sealcoating of parking lot(s) is a tried and proven maintenance method to help preserve the integrity, visual appeal, safety, and durability of the property. It can be very costly to replace or fix the asphalt in the parking lot after harsh winter weather, but the City can save significant dollars by remaining proactive with its maintenance programs. When sealcoating is applied to a parking lot surface, it adds a protective layer that acts as a barrier between the harsh environment's wear and tear, and the asphalt of your parking lot. It is advisable to refresh the asphalt's topcoat once every two or three years to maintain the durability, vitality, and

usability of the pavement. Without proper maintenance, a parking lot can fall apart beyond repair, and will then need to be replaced at significant cost. Sealcoating is extremely important in the maintenance of a parking lot for many reasons, including the following:

- 1. Extension in the life of the parking lot; and,
- 2. Prevent high repair costs; and,
- 3. Blocks the drying effects of the sun and protects against freeze and water; and,
- 4. Prevent damage from auto fluids; and.
- 5. Keep the parking lot looking acceptable and maintained.

For appearance, pavement preservation, and to help delay significant replacement costs, staff recommends awarding a contract to Hushion Pavement Maintenance, Inc., of West Chicago, Illinois, for an amount not to exceed \$42,059.00, for parking lot sealcoating and striping services at various City owned facilities during fiscal year 2020.

Adequate funds are available in the Capital Projects Fund (08-34-53-4801), Water Fund (06-34-48-4806 & 06-34-47-4420), Sewer Fund (05-34-43-4402), and the General Fund (01-09-23-4225) to cover the cost of service, depending on location.

#### ITEM SUMMARY:

As part of the City's water treatment process, rotary hydrated lime is used to purify the raw water through a softening process. When the lime bonds with targeted minerals (i.e., radium, calcium, magnesium, etc.) sludge is generated. The sludge is transferred to three exterior holding lagoons until contractually removed. The last such project was completed in late 2018 for a total project cost of \$591,242.55.

For Fiscal Year 2020, within the Water Fund (06-34-48-4210), \$700,000.00 has been budgeted for removal and disposal of waste lime sludge from the City's Water Treatment Plant lagoons (1400 Hawthorne Lane). All removed sludge must be disposed of in an EPA approved landfill.

The project was advertised in the Daily Herald on August 4, 2020, and bids were opened on August 25, 2020. There were six plan holders but only one bid was received. Heartland Recycling-Aurora CCDD, LLC of Aurora, Illinois, submitted the only bid of \$55.00 per wet ton. This cost represents an increase of \$7.75 per wet ton over the per ton project costs in 2018.

Heartland Recycling-Aurora CCDD, LLC has provided waste lime sludge removal services for the City of West Chicago in 2008, 2013, and 2018, and performed well. Heartland's references have been checked with positive comments received. Staff recommends approving Heartland Recycling-Aurora CCDD, LLC as the lowest responsible bidder for the 2020 Water Treatment Plant Waste Lime Sludge Removal Project.

Pulte Home Company, LLC is developing an 84 home subdivision, known as Trillium Farm, on approximately 34.97 acres of land generally located at the southeast corner of Gary's Mill Road and Purnell Road in unincorporated DuPage County. The subdivision includes construction of substantial public improvements, including, but not limited to, approximately 8,500 lineal feet of watermain and appurtenances, approximately 5,000 lineal feet of sanitary sewer main and appurtenance, approximately 7,000 lineal feet of storm sewer pipe and appurtenances, approximately 0.87 miles of residential roadways, approximately 27,300 square feet of public sidewalk, and a complete street light system.

With a Pre-Annexation Agreement executed between Pulte Home Company, LLC and the City of West Chicago, said public improvements will ultimately become the ownership and maintenance responsibility of the City of West Chicago. Therefore, despite the fact that said subdivision is being constructed in unincorporated DuPage County, it is extremely important that the City have full time inspection services conducted for all public improvements to ensure compliance with City standards.

Being most familiar with City's construction standards, staff desires to utilize Thomas Engineering Group, LLC for construction oversight services. Therefore, it is staff's recommendation that a contract be awarded to Thomas Engineering Group, LLC for construction oversight services related to the Trillium Farm Subdivision Development Project for an amount not to exceed \$109,830.24.

The above referenced services will be paid for using Capital Project Funds (08-34-53-4225); however, all costs incurred, plus a 25% administrative fee, will be reimbursed from Pulte Home Company, LLC per the Pre-Annexation Agreement and Appendix G of the City Code.

In August, staff and the City Attorney were asked to prepare an Elected Official Conduct Policy. Attached is a draft. The examples of prohibited behavior or conduct under "Eligibility" were taken from past concerns raised by Aldermen to staff individually outside of public meetings, responses from the City Administrator's request for such as well as from other communities' policies.  As this is a policy that would govern the conduct of the City Council members, staff merely is providing options and does not have a position on them.

#### **Elected Official Conduct Policy**

#### Purpose

It is the Policy of the City of West Chicago that all Elected Officials of the City conform their conduct to all State and Federal laws, statutes as well as the ordinances and resolutions of the City of West Chicago and the general decorum required of the Elected Position held. Upon entering upon the Office to which they are elected, each Elected Official of the City is required to take an Oath of Office affirming the faithful discharge of the duties and responsibilities as an Elected Official of the City of West Chicago.

Any Elected Official who engages in conduct in violation of said responsibility, including posting information in connection with City business or operations on social media, directly or indirectly representing that their positions or opinions are those of the City, in any forum, may be subject to sanctions and as more fully provided for herein.

#### **Eligibility**

When warranted, any Elected Official can file a Complaint against another Elected Official, as provided for herein, provided said Complaint is grounded in facts to support such a Complaint. The behavior or conduct prohibited by the Elected Official includes, but is not limited, to the following type of behavior:

- A. Possessing an interest, directly or indirectly, in a matter which may be brought before the City Council for a final decision.
- B.. Failing to disclose to the Mayor any interest the Elected Official may have which could create the appearance of an impropriety in the performance of an official act by the Elected Official.
- C. Disclosing confidential matters discussed in a properly held Executive Session Meeting outside of the Executive Session, including discussing said matters even in general terms outside of the Executive Session.
- D. Becoming involved in any matter in which the adjudicatory authority of the Elected Official may be required.
- E. Engaging in any conduct which could impact the legislative duties and responsibilities of the Elected Official, including commenting on matters individually and outside of the collective discussion at a Council or Committee Meeting.
- F. Engaging in activities, whether on social media or any other forum, which could constitute conduct unbecoming of an Elected Official. Such activities include, but are not limited to, making slanderous, libelous, disparaging or demeaning comments about other Elected

- Officials of the City or City Staff. Engaging in any conduct that brings the City in disrepute.
- G. Engaging in commentary on City managed social media platforms without City Council authorization.
- H. Using the Title or Position of the Elected Official in any correspondence, flyer, publication, social media platform or other forum to represent or imply that such are the position or views of the City Council, without authorization to do so or using or referencing said Title or Position in or at any Meeting, function or activity unrelated to the Elected Official's duties with the City.
- I. Speaking on behalf of the City, or representing himself or herself to be presenting the position or views of the City Council without City Council authorization to do so.
- J. Commenting on City matters in a capacity as a representative of the City without first obtaining verification of the information or the accuracy thereof from City Staff.
- K. Failing to seek information from City Staff to accurately convey matters pertaining to the City to the public at large.
- L. Misusing City resources, property or personnel.
- M. Using City Facilities, equipment, supplies or personnel for the Elected Official's private purposes.
- N. Engaging in disruptive conduct with City Staff or City contractors. Engaging in frequent or excessive contact with City Employees or City contractors, including contacting them outside of business hours for non-emergency related matters. Leaving harassing or inappropriate voicemails or text messages to City Employees, City conractors or other Elected Officials of the City.
- O. Utilizing the services of the City Attorney's Office without advising the City Administrator of the general nature of the matter, unless such is not feasible or the matter involves or pertains to the City Administrator. The City Attorney attends the Meetings of the City Council, certain Committee Meetings and Executive Sessions thereof, as communications with the City Attorney's Office in this setting allows input from other Elected Officials and permits the City Attorney to provide any opinions or directives to the entire City Council.
- P. Engaging in any conduct which will or could have an adverse effect on City operations or efficiencies.
- Q. Using vulgar language in any Public Building or Facility of the City.
- R. Performing an official act with the intent to directly and adversely affect a business within the City, except in acting in the official capacity of the Elected Official.

- S. Participating with any organization with a matter pending before the City, without disclosing same to the Mayor.
- T. Failing to disclose to the Mayor any interests or involvement with any Organization transacting business with the City or in which said Organization is seeking relief of some type from the City.
- U. Using any City Employee Directory for any reason unrelated to official City business.
- V. Engaging in misconduct in connection with the Elected Office held.
- W. Publicly criticizing City employees or getting involved in administrative functions that are the responsibility of the City Administrator or other City employees, including, but not limited to, attending staff meetings as well as getting involved in recruitment and other employment decisions for which the Elected Officials are not responsible.

#### **Complaint Guidelines**

- A. A Complaint against any Elected Official shall be handled as follows:
  - 1. The Complaint shall be presented to the Mayor. The Council will, as soon thereafter as practicable, convene an Executive Session, in accordance with the Illinois Open Meeting Act, 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(1), for purposes of discussing the Complaint. A majority vote of the City Council is required to allow the Complaint to move forward for a Sanctions Hearing and determination. If a majority of the City Council agrees, in Executive Session, the Complaint shall be put in writing and presented to the Elected Official against whom the allegations are directed.
- B. Said Elected Official shall have the following rights in the Complaint process:
  - 1. The opportunity to respond to the Complaint; and
  - 2. The opportunity to participate in any informal resolutions of the Complaint; and
  - 3. The opportunity to have a Hearing on the Complaint; and
  - 4. The opportunity to speak to the nature of the Sanctions sought to be imposed in the event the City Council determines sanctions are appropriate, as provided for herein.
- C. Neither the Elected Official making the Complaint, nor the Elected Official against whom the Complaint is directed, shall be subjected to any unjust treatment as a result of either filing the Complaint or being the Complainant.
- D. Any extension of time needed to comply with the Complaint procedures set forth herein will be by agreement of the parties, for good cause shown.

E. The Elected Official filing the Complaint may submit a written request to withdraw his/her Complaint at any time.

#### **Complaint Procedures**

Complaints will be processed in the following manner, within the stated time limits:

#### **Step I:** Initial Complaint

The Elected Official will be presented, in writing, with the Complaint. The Complaint must be presented within ten (10) working days from the date of the conduct complained of, or as soon thereafter as practicable, given the schedule of the City Council Meetings.

#### Step II: Presentation of Complaint/Hearing with the City Council

The Complaint will be presented to the City Council by the Mayor in a Closed Executive Session, at a time determined by the Mayor. The accused Elected Official shall be given Notice of the Complaint and the Meeting scheduled to present the Complaint, no less than forty-eight (48) hours prior to the conduct of said Executive Session. An informal presentation of the Complaint shall be made to the whole City Council. The accused Elected Official shall have an opportunity to respond to the Complaint. Only information pertinent to the Complaint shall be discussed.

If the matter is not resolved through the information discussion of the City Council and it appears as though the implementation of discipline may be warranted, the matter shall be advanced for a Hearing before the City Council, as provided for herein.

#### **Step III: Sanction Procedures**

When a violation is determined by the City Council to be serious enough to possibly warrant discipline of the Elected Official, the matter shall be scheduled for a Hearing before the City Council. The accused Elected Official shall be provided a copy of the written Complaint. A Hearing, in Executive Session, shall be scheduled by the Mayor at a time and date convenient for the accused Elected Official, however, in no event shall the Hearing be extended beyond a period of thirty (30) days, unless good cause is shown for said extension.

The City Council shall present the information and evidence relating to the Complaint. The accused Elected Official will then be afforded an opportunity to respond to the information presented in support of the Complaint and to provide and offer any information or evidence in support of his or her defense to the allegations in the Complaint. Thereafter, the City Council will deliberate, in the presence of the accused Elected Official, and will determine whether sufficient information was provided to support the allegations in the Complaint and, if so, whether discipline of the accused Elected Official is necessary and/or appropriate.

When a violation is determined by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the City Council Members present, including the Mayor, after affording the accused Elected Official an opportunity to be heard, the City Council may impose discipline, as provided for herein. The discipline imposed shall be

determined based upon the same two-thirds (2/3) vote of the City Council. The City Council can thereafter determine, by a two-thirds (2/3) vote as to whether any discipline imposed shall be done in an Open or Closed session Meeting of the City Council.

#### **Discipline Options**

#### Oral Reprimand/Censure

When it is determined that an Elected Official violates a rule, regulation, policy or procedure of the City Council, which violation or any such conduct impacts City Council operations, City Council relations or City Council/Staff interaction, after a Hearing, as provided for above, the City Council may impose an Oral Reprimand or Censure against the Elected Official found to be in violation of same. The determination to impose said sanction must be approved by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the City Council Members present, including the Mayor.

#### Written Reprimand

When it is determined that an Elected Official violates a rule, regulation, policy or procedure of the City Council, which violation or any such conduct impacts City operations, City Council relations or City Council/Staff interaction, which is more serious in nature or which is a continuation of a violation previously determined, after a Hearing, as provided for above, the City Council may impose a Written Reprimand against the Elected Official found to be in violation of same. The determination to impose said sanction must be approved by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the City Council Members present, including the Mayor.

#### **Meeting Suspension**

When it is determined that an Elected Official commits a serious violation of a rule, regulation, policy or procedure of the City, which violation or any such conduct has a serious impact on City operations, City relations or City Council/Staff interaction, and which is more serious in nature or which is a repeat or continuation of a violation previously determined, after a Hearing, as provided for above, the City Council may impose a Suspension of the Elected Official found to be in violation of same from a City Council Meeting or Committee of the Whole Meeting, the date of which Meeting, shall be specifically identified. The determination to impose said sanction must be approved by a vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the City Council Members present, including the Mayor.

#### **Step IV: Decisions Final**

It is understood that the Decision, as reflected in said vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the City Council Members present, including the Mayor shall be a final Decision. The City Council shall maintain the Meeting Minutes of all Executive Session and Open Session Meetings, as required by law.
