Dear West Chicago Resident;

West Chicago has been selected to be a part of DuPage Habitat for Humanity's first Community Cares Week. Community Cares Week brings together volunteers to do exterior home repair projects for residents in a selected community within Habitat's service area. We will be bringing together small groups of volunteers from across DuPage County to your community May 25th-May 29th. Since our first Community Cares week is happening in West Chicago, we have decided to call it WeGo Community Cares week! Information on how to volunteer for this event will be available on our website starting in April 2021.

We are currently accepting pre-applications for exterior repair from West Chicago
Homeowners. To qualify, the applicant's household income has to fall below 80% of
Area Median Income for the Chicagoland Area (chart to the right). Priority will be
given to repairs that affect the applicant's quality of life. A portion of the repair cost
will be repaid by the applicant based on their income at time of application.

Applications will be accepted in person, by mail, or through email until 5pm on Friday, March 19th.

- <u>Right of Entry.</u> Based on the repairs requested in the Home Repair Program Pre-Application, the Homeowner understands that a substantial portion of the Work will be performed on the Homeowner's residence. Accordingly, Homeowner agrees that Habitat and its agents, contractors, employees and volunteers may have access to the interior of the Property for the purpose of: (i) assessing, inspecting, measuring and gathering information related to the requested repairs; (ii) installing, implementing, constructing, or otherwise performing activities related to the requested repairs; and (iii) performing any other such actions as are reasonably contemplated by the Program and this Pre-Application.
- 2. Limitation of Liability. Neither Habitat nor its agents, contractors, directors, employees, officers, volunteers or other representatives shall have any liability or responsibility for any damages, loss or injury of any kind, direct or indirect, to any person or to any property in any way caused by or resulting from the performance of the Work in connection with this application, except as caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of Habitat or any of the above-designated persons. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, to the extent that Habitat is found liable for property damage to the Property in accordance with this Section 9, Habitat shall compensate Homeowner only for the reasonable documented cost of necessary repairs.
