ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION

July 20, 2022, 7:00 P.M.

Annual Paper Shredding Event

Kay McKeen was contacted and she said the amount of sharps and expired medications was six full bins, which have been averaging 40 pounds each, about 240 pounds.

Rain barrel Partner Program

Commissioner Brown said she had a discussion with Susanna Ball about hosting a seminar at Ball Horticultural Company. She received positive a response, especially if the talk is about gardens or pollinator gardens. It may also meet one of the Mayors Monarch Pledge goals for Public Education. This

is still open for discussion as to when it could occur. Fall was suggested, when kids are back in school. Probably in the middle of the week.
