- 1. Call to Order. Mayor Ruben Pineda called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

#### ITEM SUMMARY:

As part of the City's water treatment process, rotary hydrated lime is used to purify the raw water through a softening process. When the lime bonds with targeted minerals (i.e., radium, calcium, magnesium, etc.) sludge is generated. The sludge is transferred to three exterior holding lagoons until contractually removed. The last such project was undertaken in late 2020 for a total project cost of \$700,000.00.

The project was initially advertised for bids in the Daily Herald on July 5, 2022, and no bids were received. The project was re-advertised for bid on August 2, 2022, and only one bid was received on August 19<sup>th</sup>. The sole bid received was in excess of the funds budgeted for the project. The Infrastructure Committee formally rejected the bid on September 1, 2022.

Heartland Recycling – Aurora CCDD, LLC contacted staff requesting to exercise the renewal clause in its contract from the previous project in 2020. They also requested the City to approve cost increases over 2020 pricing due to significant changes in the economic climate since then. Staff recognized the validity of the request and negotiated a new price per ton reflective of the current economic climate. Heartland reps offered a proposal with pricing of \$76.85 per wet ton, guaranteed through June 30, 2023. This quote represents a total of \$1,229,600.00 for the entire project, which exceeds the budgeted amount for 2022. The additional funds necessary, approximately \$349,600.00, to complete project in 2023 will be allocated in the FY2023 budget.

Heartland staff will be able to mobilize and believes that it is capable of removing approximately 10,000 tons of material by the end of 2022. The removal quantity of 10,000 wet tons represents approximately two-thirds of the bid quantity. This approach was discussed with the Infrastructure Committee on September 1, 2022, and the Committee members were in favor of it.

Heartland Recycling – Aurora CCDD, LLC has provided waste lime sludge removal services for the City of West Chicago in 2008, 2013, 2018, and 2020, and has performed well in each instance. Heartland will be bringing the same team to the project as was used in the 2020 project. Staff recommends approving Heartland Recycling – Aurora CCDD, LLC for the 2022-2023 Water Treatment Plant Waste Lime Sludge Removal Project.

For Fiscal Year 2022, within the Water Fund (06-34-48-4210), \$880,000.00 was budgeted for removal and disposal of waste lime sludge from the City's Water Treatment Plant Iagoons (1400 W. Hawthorne Lane). The remainder of the cost (\$349,600.00) will be budgeted for the completion of the project in 2023. All removed sludge will be disposed of in an EPA approved landfill.

#### **ITEM SUMMARY:**

The remaining environmental remediation of the former Rare Earth Facility site on the City's south side, also referred to as the former Kerr-McGee site, will be concluding in the next 3-5 years. Once completed, the property will be transferred to the City. The City intends to eventually construct a community park on the property. Before this occurs, the City will develop a master plan of the future park. City staff recently advertised for professional services to assist the City with these plans and design services for the future park project. The City has budgeted \$25,000 for this planning process.

City staff received two proposals for these services including Hitchcock Design Group and Upland Design Ltd. The quote from Hitchcock design group was over budget at \$36,800 while Upland Design Ltd. provided a quote slightly less than the budgeted amount at \$23,200, with other reimbursable costs (printing, mileage, etc.). Upland Design Ltd. is an accomplished firm that has extensive experience in the Chicagoland area with park planning that focuses on community input. Staff is recommending that the City Council authorize the Mayor to enter into the contract agreement with Upland Design Ltd. for professional services.

The planning process will take approximately 3-4 months commencing in early October and anticipated to be completed in January of 2023. The main components of the park planning services include site analysis, needs assessment, various community outreach efforts including multiple public input meetings, development of a master plan, phasing plan, and construction cost estimates. Budgeting for the implementation and construction will not occur until 2024 at the earliest. This timeframe allows the City time to identify revenue and partnership resources for the desired park.

#### **ACTIONS PROPOSED:**

Consideration and recommendation of a contract with Upland Design Ltd. for park planning services.

#### **COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION:**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of West Chicago, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: That pursuant to 40 ILCS 5/7-135, Nikki Giles is hereby appointed as the authorized agent to the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: That as the authorized agent, Nikki Giles shall have the following powers and duties:

- 1. To certify to the Fund whether or not a given person is authorized to participate in the Fund:
- 2. To certify to the Fund when a participating employee is on leave of absence authorized by the City;
- 3. To request the proper office to cause employee contributions to be withheld from earnings and transmitted to the Fund;
- 4. To request the proper office to cause City contributions to be withheld from earnings and transmitted to the Fund;
- 5. To forward promptly to all participating employees any communications from the Fund for such employees;
- 6. To forward promptly to the Fund all applications, claims, reports and other communications delivered to her by the participating employees;
- 7. To perform all duties related to the administration of this retirement system as requested by the Fund and the governing body of the City;
- 8. To file a petition for nomination of an executive trustee of the Fund; and
- 9. To cast the ballot for election of executive trustee of the Fund.

SECTION 3: That the Executive Assistant be and the same is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, together with a properly completed "Notice of Appointment of Authorized Agent" on the form provided by the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: That all resolutions in conflict with the provision of this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed.

<u>SECTION5</u>: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.

- 1. Payment shall be in U.S. Dollars, CLIENT shall be responsible for payment (without deduction or offset from the total invoice amount) of any and all sales, use, value added, gross receipts, franchise and like taxes, and tariffs and duties, and all disposal fees and taxes, levied against APTIM or its employees by any government or taxing authority. A service charge equal to one and one-half percent (1 1/2 %) per month, or the maximum rate permitted by law, whichever is less, will be added to all accounts which remain unpaid for more than thirty (30) calendar days beyond the date of the invoice. Should there be any dispute as payments to be made on a percent complete basis to any portion of an invoice, the undisputed portion shall be promptly paid.

In the event APTIM is requested or authorized by CLIENT, or is required by government regulation, subpoena, or other legal process to produce documents or personnel as witnesses with respect to the Services performed under this Agreement, CLIENT agrees, so long as APTIM is not a party to the proceeding in which the information is sought, to reimburse APTIM for its professional time and expenses, as well as the fees and expenses of counsel, incurred in responding to such requests.

3. CLIENT'S COOPERATION: To assist APTIM in performing the Services, CLIENT shall (i) provide APTIM with relevant material, data, and information in its possession pertaining to the specific project or activity, (ii) consult with APTIM when requested, (iii) permit APTIM reasonable access to relevant CLIENT sites, (iv) ensure reasonable cooperation of CLIENT's employees in APTIM's activities, and (v) notify and report to all regulatory agencies as required by such agencies.

4. Nothing herein is meant to prevent nor shall be interpreted as preventing either party from disclosing and/or using any information or data (i) when the information or data are actually known to the receiving party before being obtained or derived from the transmitting party, (ii) when information or data are generally available to the public without the receiving party's fault at any time before or after it is acquired from the transmitting party; (iii) where the information or data are obtained or acquired in good faith at any time by the receiving party from a third party who has the same in good faith and who is not under any obligation to the transmitting party in respect thereto; (iv) where a written release is obtained by the receiving party from the transmitting party; (v) three (3) years from the date of receipt of such information; or (vi) when required by process of law; provided, however, upon service of such process, the recipient thereof shall use reasonable efforts to notify the other party and afford it an opportunity to resist such process.

CLIENT shall obtain APTIM's prior consent and cooperation with the formulation and release of any public disclosure in connection with this Agreement or work performed hereunder, before issuing a news release, public announcement, advertisement, or other form of publicity.

5. RIGHT TO USE INFORMATION AND DOCUMENTS: CLIENT may use any final reports of findings, feasibility studies, industrial hygiene and safety, engineering work or other work performed or prepared by APTIM under this Agreement for its internal purposes in connection with the project and/or location indicated in the Services for which such work was prepared, but APTIM reserves all other rights with respect to such documents and all other documents produced in performing the Services. CLIENT shall obtain prior written consent from APTIM for any other use, distribution, or publication of such reports or work results. Unless otherwise expressly agreed to in writing, nothing in this Agreement shall be interpreted to prevent APTIM from application and use of any information

learned by it from the services (subject to the provisions of Section 4). All reports will be delivered subject to APTIM's then current limitations and disclaimers.

Information submitted to CLIENT by APTIM hereunder is not intended nor shall such submission constitute inducement and/or contribution to infringe any patent(s) owned by a third party, and APTIM specifically disclaims any liability therefor.
- 7. DELAYS AND CHANGES IN CONDITIONS: If APTIM is delayed or otherwise in any way hindered or impacted at any time in performing the Services by (i) an act, failure to act or neglect of CLIENT or CLIENT's employees or any third parties: (ii) changes in the scope of the work; (iii) unforeseen, differing or changed circumstances or conditions including differing site conditions, acts of force majeure (such as fires, floods, riots, and strikes); (iv) changes in government acts or regulations; (v) delay authorized by CLIENT and agreed to by APTIM; or (vi) any other cause beyond the reasonable control of APTIM, then 1) the time for completion of the Services shall be extended based upon the impact of the delay, and 2) APTIM shall receive an equitable compensation adjustment.
- 8. - e. SEVERABILITY AND SURVIVAL Each provision of this Agreement is severable from the others. Should any provision of this Agreement be found invalid or unenforceable, such provision shall be ineffective only to the extent required by law, without

invalidating the remainder of such provision or the remainder of this Agreement.

Further, to the extent permitted by law, any provision found invalid or unenforceable shall be deemed automatically redrawn to the extent necessary to render it valid and enforceable consistent with the parties' intent. For example, if the gross negligence standard in Section 11 is unenforceable under an applicable "anti-indemnity" statute, but a sole negligence standard is enforceable, the sole negligence standard shall be automatically substituted therefor. The terms and conditions set forth herein shall survive the termination of this Agreement.
