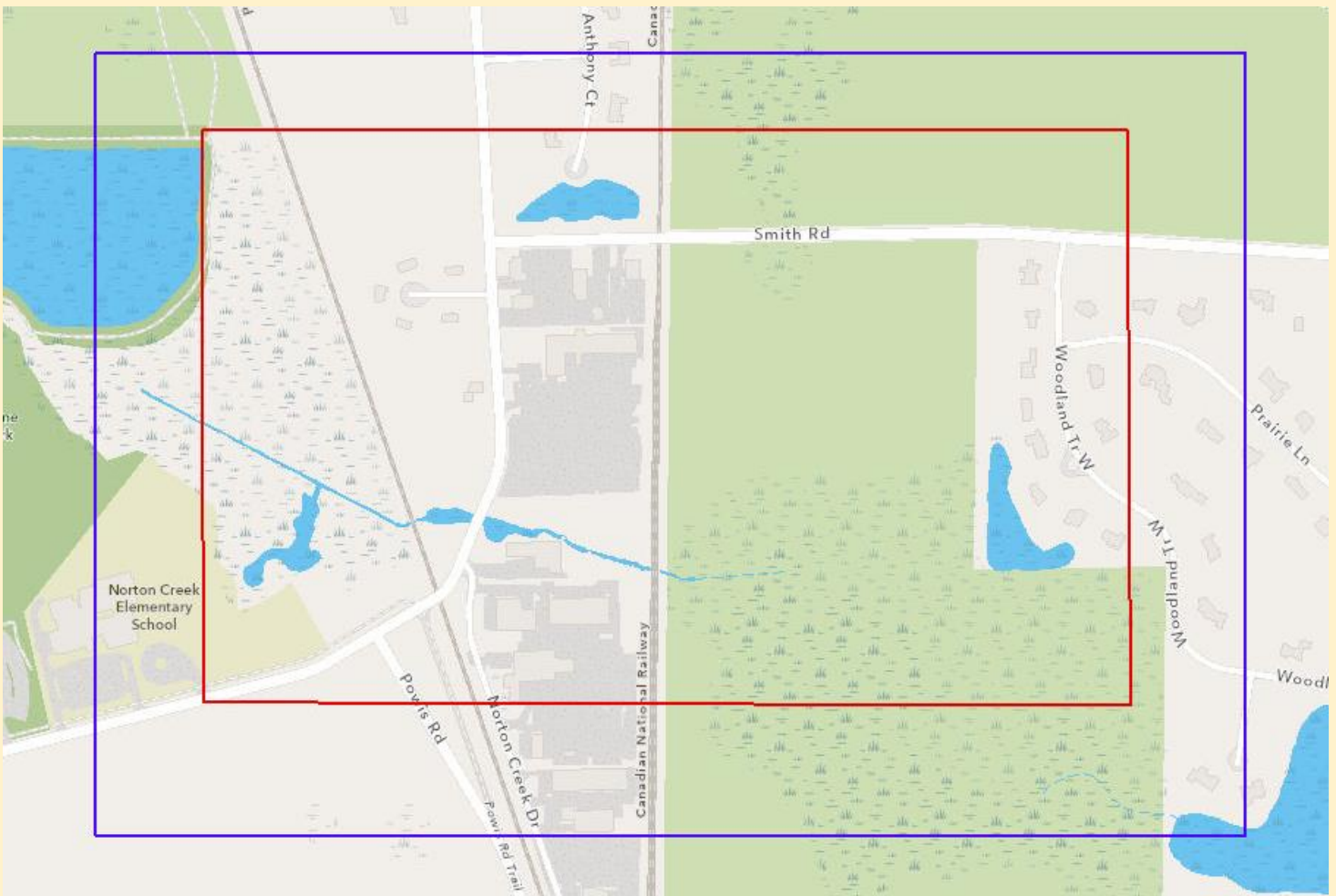

Illinois Department of Agriculture in cooperation with the US Forest Service's Slow the Spread Program have proposed treatment areas for spraying to control the Spongy Moth. Depending on weather, Foray 48 B, Btk or Bacillus thuringiensis kurstaki will be sprayed from a helicopter in mid-late May
